- Copy of your College of Teachers' Certificate of Qualifications is to be included as part of your application package (attach as separate document)
- Copy of your most recent (within 5 years) TPA (for VP candidates) or PPA (for Principal candidates) (attach as separate document)
- Proof of completion of Special Education Qualification - Part 1 or equivalent (if not listed on OCT)
- Reference Statement - External candidates only (found on Page 5 of Application Package)
