## SECONDARY SUPERINTENDENT OF EDUCATION

The Grand Erie District School Board is seeking a dynamic, passionate and dedicated educational leader to provide ongoing support to create positive outcomes for students. The Grand Erie District School Board is inviting applications for the position of Superintendent of Education.

We are located in the southern portion of the province of Ontario. The Board spans a geographic area encompassing the City of Brantford and the Counties of Brant, Haldimand and Norfolk and the main office is located in Brantford. The district serves 26,300 students, including 480 on Education Services Agreements. The district has 58 elementary schools and 14 secondary schools, in rural and urban settings, with 2,800 employees.

Successful applicants for the Superintendent of Education, grades 9-12 must hold a Supervisory Officer certificate. We are seeking applicants with extensive, successful experience in secondary schools and a commitment to Indigenous Education.

As a member of the Board's senior administrative team, the successful candidate will:

- demonstrate expertise as a strong instructional leader.
- demonstrate the ability to motivate, lead and supervise an area of secondary schools.
- supervise all Indigenous Education K-12.
- participate on the Indigenous Education Advisory Committee and Native Advisory Committee.
- have proven ability to develop the capacities of staff by building on their strengths.
- have experience with, understanding of and ability to facilitate learning communities.
- motivate, lead and promote systematic use of assessment and evidence-based data to improve student learning outcomes.
- demonstrate superior leadership ability, communication and organizational skills, and proven commitment to student success, equity and well-being.
- work in partnership and collaborate with a team of system leaders.
- have a minimum of five years of successful experience as a principal with a proven focus on Indigenous Education.
