### 2022 Membership Tax Receipts

If you pay your OPC membership fees by cheque or credit card, paid retroactive fees by cheque or credit card during 2022, are employed by Renfrew or Superior-Greenstone or are a Term Member, your 2022 membership tax receipt is available on our <u>website</u> under My Profile, Member Tax Rec, 2022. If you pay by payroll deduction, use the amount recorded in box 44 on the T4 slip. Claim the amount on the T4 slip or on your OPC membership tax receipt, not both. You may not need the receipt, but you can keep a copy for your records. Associate fees are not tax deductible, but copies are available on our website under My Profile, Associate Rec, 2022.
