Bargaining Update

As you know, our Provincial Terms and Conditions agreement will expire on August 31. Representatives from the OPC, CPCO and ADFO will work together to represent principals and vice-principals from across the province during negotiations. The Crown and Trustee Associations have indicated a preference to complete their negotiations with the teacher and staff unions before bargaining with us. We will, however, continue the work of our provincial subcommittees including Benefits, Compensation and Recruitment & Retention. We are currently working on developing a list of the items that will be our priorities at the bargaining table. To collect this data from Members, a survey is being developed, which you can expect to receive in the next 4-6 weeks. We encourage you to respond, as your input and suggestions will form the basis of our planning going forward.
