We are very pleased that a deal (subject to ratification) was reached last night between CUPE, the Crown and the school boards' association. It's great news that today, our students are in class, our staff are in the building and our schools are open. We are also very relieved that the additional duties and responsibilities so many of you were asked to manage last week, and the possibility of more being asked of those of you in schools that would have remained open had a strike ensued, have come to an end.

Following CUPE's announcement last week that a strike was possible, we felt compelled to issue <u>a public statement</u> outlining our concerns about the impact of work-to-rule so far and the negative implications for students and our Members. It was important for the voices of principals and vice-principals to be heard – and we believe they were – by the government, school boards and union, especially in relation to our commitment to equity of access for all students during times of labour unrest. **Twitter Chat**
