Call for EDI Sub-Committee Members

The Equity, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Advisory Committee is launching two sub-committees focused on Professional Development and Recruitment, Retention and Advancement. Long-term Disability (LTD) Coverage End Dates

Under the OPC Benefits plan, there are five LTD options, LTD1-LTD5. Your eligibility for the option you have chosen is subject to certain eligibility timelines.

- LTD1, 2 and 5 you are covered until the date you are eligible for a 70% unreduced pension (generally after 35 years of qualifying service)
- LTD3 and 4 you are eligible until the date you reach your 85 factor (age plus working experience), age 65 or the date you retire.

It is your responsibility to notify us of your pension eligibility, as we do not have access to that information. Premium deductions will continue until we receive written notice that you have reached your pension eligibility, retirement date or age 65, and wish to terminate your coverage. Premiums are non-refundable.

You can confirm your eligibility by visiting the <u>Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan website</u>. Your LTD option is shown on your benefits profile, which can be accessed on <u>our website</u> by clicking on "My Profile" in the upper right corner of the homepage (login is required). If you have or will soon reach any of the above pension eligibility dates, complete and return the <u>Application to</u> <u>Terminate Insurance Coverage form</u> and provide the required documents to support the request for termination, as applicable.
